

WELCOME! The Goldfields Regional Toy Library provides your family the opportunity to choose from over 1,200 fun and educational toys to borrow. We value your membership and know your family will love the Toy Library.

Opening Hours

Tuesday 9.30am - 11am & Thursday 3.30pm - 5pm. Please ensure you allow enough time to return, choose and borrow toys.



Loaning

- Your membership allows you to borrow 6 toys for 3 weeks at a time, with the option to renew once. This can be done at your next visit or by logging on at grtl.setls.com.au.
- The Committee reserves the right to request an early return of toy(s) you have on loan, for use at Community Events throughout the year.



Missing / Broken Pieces

- We understand damage and loss can occur. If the toy is returned with missing piece(s) we may ask that you borrow the toy for a further 3 weeks while you try to find them. Before returning, log onto SETLS to see if the toy has a missing piece recorded.
- If missing piece(s) cannot be found, a fine of \$5.00 per piece may be charged at the discretion of the Committee. If the piece/s are subsequently found and returned, you will be refunded.
- If a toy is broken or there are so many missing piece/s that it renders the toy unusable, at the discretion of the Committee, you may be asked to assist us in replacing the toy.



Roster Duty

- We ask that you consider assisting with opening the toy library 3-4 times a year. You can nominate yourself online in SETLS or speak to the Committee Member on duty. An extra pair of hands is invaluable on a really busy day and always welcomed 😊
- Children are welcome to play at the Toy Library during a duty. We ask that you ensure all toys are tidied at the end of the shift.

Toy Care

- Please ensure you return toys clean and ready for the next borrower.
- Please keep your pets away from our toys. If they are returned damaged, we will ask you to pay for a replacement.
- Do not leave toys in the sun for long periods of time, especially during Summer.

Safety - Please read this section carefully

We follow Toy Libraries Australia (TLA) recommendations as much as possible. Warning labels are attached to toys that have small parts, and/or not suitable for children under 3 years old or those who still put items in their mouths.



By receiving this Guide, you have read, understood and agree to the following:

- Check all toys and parts before allowing children play with them
- Inform a Committee Member if there is any damage to toys, have lost their warning labels, or you feel are unsafe in any way
- Do not allow children to access the storage boxes, bags or straps
- Ensure the toy is appropriate for the age and ability of the child
- Ensure the toy is used in the appropriate manner and for the purpose in which it was intended
- Supervise your children while using water play toys and those with small parts
- Supervise your children while visiting the Toy Library
- GRTL waiver, release and indemnity for bicycle and scooters as below:



The Goldfields Regional Toy Library ("Provider") is pleased to make bicycles and scooters available to subscribers ("the Service").

As a subscriber to the Service you acknowledge that there are dangers and risks inherent with bicycle and scooter riding (the "Activity") to which any child under your supervision ("Your Child") may be exposed.

The Provider does not provide protective cloth or bicycle helmets and it is your responsibility to ensure that Your Child will participate in the Activity at your own risk. You also agree to voluntarily assume responsibility for supervising the Activity and any injury, death or property damage you or Your Child may suffer or cause as a result of participating in the Activity.

To the maximum extent possible at law, you (both in your personal capacity and on behalf of Your Child) agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify the Provider and its respective officers, employees, servants, agents and contractors (the "Indemnified Persons") against all actions, claims, suits, costs, expenses, demands and damages suffered or incurred by the Indemnified Persons or any one or more of them by reason of, or in respect of, or in any manner whatsoever arising out of, or caused by, your use of the Service or Your Child's participation in the Activity.

You agree that you are subscribing to the Service on the express condition that the Provider:

(a) will, under no circumstances be liable or responsible in any manner whatsoever for any death, loss, accident, damage or injury to you, Your Child or any of your servants, agents, contractors, visitors or invitees or any other person whatsoever ("Related Party") which may happen as a result of your use of the Service or Your Child participating in the Activity; and (b) will not incur or be under any liability whatsoever to you, Your Child, or to any Related Party for any loss, damage or injury to or in respect of any of your property or of any Related Party's property.

The Provider is not liable to you, Your Child or any Related Party in respect of any indirect or consequential loss. For the avoidance of doubt, 'consequential loss' means loss or damage arising from a breach of contract, tort (including negligence), under statute or any other basis in law or equity of an indirect or consequential nature including, but without limitation, loss of profits, loss of revenue, loss or denial of opportunity, loss of goodwill, loss of business reputation, future reputation or publicity, damage to credit rating and indirect, remote, abnormal or unforeseeable loss, or any similar loss whether or not in the reasonable contemplation of the parties.
