The Willetton Toy Library is a volunteer run organisation that provides your family the opportunity to borrow from 500 fun and educational toys. We value your membership and hope your family will love using the Toy Library.

Opening hours

Wednesday & Friday 9:30am to 10:30am.

Please ensure you allow enough time to return, choose and borrow toys.

Toy Borrowing & Click & Collect

You can borrow up to 4 toys for up to three weeks depending on your level of membership. Click & collect is available on the online catalogue at [Willetton Toy Library \(setls.com.au\)](http://Willetton Toy Library (setls.com.au))

Missing / Broken Pieces

We understand that damage and loss can occur. If the toy is returned with missing piece/s we ask that you re-borrow the whole toy for a further three weeks and attempt to find them. Many pieces are found this way. If pieces cannot be found, a fine of \$5 per piece is charged. If the piece/s are subsequently found and returned, your fine will be refunded.

If a toy is broken or the missing piece/s render the toy useless, you may be required to pay the replacement cost.

Roster Duty & Stocktake

We ask that you assist at the toy library 4 times a year. You can nominate yourself online or speak to the Committee Member on duty. Children are always welcome however they must be supervised.

The Toy Library conducts an audit of all toys at the end of every year (Nov/Dec). All members are required to return the toys to the Toy Library beforehand. Members (or a relative) have to attend stocktake for a minimum of 2 hours. Sorry, for safety reasons, children are not permitted to attend stocktake. If unable to attend, we request that you take some items home to clean such as puzzles, board games or costumes. If you do not notify us that you are unable to attend, we will issue a \$20 fine. The Toy Library closes for 6 weeks after stocktake for the Christmas holiday period.

Toy Care

- Please ensure you return toys clean and ready for the next borrower.
- Keep your pets away from our toys. If they are returned damaged, we will ask you to pay for a replacement.
- Do not leave toys in the sun for long periods of time, especially during summer.

Safety

Please read this section carefully

We follow Toy Libraries Australia (TLA) recommendations as much as possible. Warning labels are attached to toys that have small parts, and/or not suitable for children under 3 years old or those who still put items in their mouths.

By receiving this Guide, you have read, understood and agree to the following:

- Check all toys and parts before allowing children play with them.
- Inform a Committee Member if any of the toys are broken, have lost their warning labels, or you feel are unsafe in any way.
- Do not allow children to access the storage boxes or bags, if destroyed we may ask you to pay for a replacement.
- Ensure the toy is appropriate for the age and ability of the child.
- Ensure the toy is used in the appropriate manner and for the purpose in which it was intended.
- Supervise your children while using water play toys and those with small parts.
- Supervise your children while visiting the Toy Library.
- RCTL waiver, release and indemnity for bicycle and scooters as below:

The Willetton Toy Library ("Provider") is pleased to make bicycles and scooters available to subscribers ("the Service").

As a subscriber to the Service you acknowledge that there are dangers and risks inherent with bicycle and scooter riding (the "Activity") to which any child under your supervision ("Your Child") may be exposed.

The Provider does not provide protective clothing or bicycle helmets and it is your responsibility to ensure that Your Child will participate in the Activity at your own risk. You also agree to voluntarily assume responsibility for supervising the Activity and any injury, death or property damage you or Your Child may suffer or cause as a result of participating in the Activity.

To the maximum extent possible at law, you (both in your personal capacity and on behalf of Your Child) agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify the Provider and its respective officers, employees, servants, agents and contractors (the "Indemnified Persons") against all actions, claims, suits, costs, expenses, demands and damages suffered or incurred by the Indemnified Persons or any one or more of them by reason of, or in respect of, or in any manner whatsoever arising out of, or caused by, your use of the Service or Your Child's participation in the Activity.

You agree that you are subscribing to the Service on the express condition that the Provider:

(a) will, under no circumstances be liable or responsible in any manner whatsoever for any death, loss, accident, damage or injury to you, Your Child or any of your servants, agents, contractors, visitors or invitees or any other person whatsoever ("Related Party") which may happen as a result of your use of the Service or Your Child participating in the Activity; and (b) will not incur or be under any liability whatsoever to you, Your Child, or to any Related Party for any loss, damage or injury to or in respect of any of your property or of any Related Party's property.

The Provider is not liable to you, Your Child or any Related Party in respect of any indirect or consequential loss. For the avoidance of doubt, 'consequential loss' means loss or damage arising from a breach of contract, tort (including negligence), under statute or any other basis in law or equity of an indirect or consequential nature including, but without limitation, loss of profits, loss of revenue, loss or denial of opportunity, loss of goodwill, loss of business reputation, future reputation or publicity, damage to credit rating and indirect, remote, abnormal or unforeseeable loss, or any similar loss whether or not in the reasonable contemplation of the parties.
